care products, tinned meals, winter essentials (wool/fleece hats, gloves, socks), water purification tabs.

My mother's family were refugees in France at the outbreak of WW2. With three kids, they were evicted from their home in Alsace-Lorraine and spent three years on the move. My uncle was born while they were staying in the office of a bus company. My mother was the first born after they settled in a derelict house near Macon in southern Burgundy in 1944. She and her family faced disadvantage for many years as a result of this. Those affected and displaced by conflict need our help.
