His film credits include Jaws, Gandhi, Star Wars Episode IV, Batman, Monty Python's Life of Brian, Lord of the Rings - The Two Towers and six Bond themes! His numerous TV scores include Dr Who, Inspector Morse and Tales of the Unexpected.

Appropriately, Crispian plays the theme tune for the BBC's Antiques Roadshow as he collects and restores antique trumpets upon which he has performed and recorded much of the world's greatest music with The Academy of Ancient Music, The Kings Consort and The English Baroque Soloists.
