## The Windmill 2025

We have exciting plans for 2025 and beyond.

In short, our plan is to further renovate the windmill such that when the wind blows, the sails will rotate. This is a substantial project of work. We will need to replace the four existing sails, manufacture shutters for the sails and repair or replace the windshaft bearings. There's bound to be more work as we progress through the renovation. We estimate that the work will take three to four years to complete and cost an estimated £150,000. But it is worth it. The outcome will be magnificent, rotating sails for all to admire on selected days.

We need to accelerate our fundraising activities and part of this activity is to look into extending the site down the Barley Road. The plan is that if we can increase footfall, host larger groups, for example school visits and hold small events, we will be able to secure more funds. Extending the site requires conservation planning permission. The Trustees are engaged on this exercise but we are inexperienced on such matters.
